Subject: Academic year 2017-18 Curriculum planning and assessment.

Dear Head of Institutions,

As you are aware, CBSE has announced various changes with respect to evaluation and assessment in last few days. DAVCAE conducts **annual examination in Grade VIII and XI** each year with the objective that our students can get a fair idea of grade X as well as grade XII board examination. Keeping the various directives of CBSE in mind it has been decided that in case of grade VIII the entire academic year will be divided in **two terms**. DAVCAE will conduct examination at the end of each term.

1. Each term will have a distribution of **(80 written + 20 internal assessment)** where 80 marks are allotted to written examination and 20 marks are allotted for internal assessment.
2. Term end examination at the end of each term which will be 100 marks.
3. At the time of result preparation the 100 marks of written examination will be reduced to 80 to get final total of 100(i.e. 80 written exam + 20 internal assessment).
4. The final exam conducted at the end of term II will also be of 100 marks reduced to 80(again 80 marks for written exam and 20 internal assessment).
5. It will be mandatory for a student to qualify term I examination by scoring atleast 25% marks in written examination to be able to appear for term II.
6. A retest will be conducted for all students who are not able to get qualifying marks at the end of term I by DAVCAE.
7. Entire syllabus of term I and term II will be covered in the final examination which will be conducted at the end of term II.
8. Syllabus document may be referred to for detailed syllabus bifurcation and other details.

NOTE: DAVCAE will conduct term end examination for both terms i.e term I and II in case of grade VIII and year end annual examination in case of grade XI.
