

COMMON NOUN

• Common noun refers to the name of a non-specific person, place, animal or a thing.



Since these nouns are not naming anything specific, they do not need to start with capital letters unless they begin a sentence.

Proper noun refers to the name of a specific person, place, animal or a thing.



Since these nouns are naming specific things, they begin with a capital letter.
