

Working Note on Master Trainer Programme(s) -2018 For Senior Secondary Teachers Teaching History

1. Selection Criteria

The Master Trainer will be identified/selected by Cluster Heads/Principals on the basis of:

- 1) Teacher's performance -displaying not only excellent teaching skills but also creativity.
- 2) Strong personal values.
- 3) Positive attitude.
- 4) The ability to address large gatherings with strong communication skills.
- 5) Willing to travel as and when required.
- 6) Research oriented, scientific temperament.
- 7) Willing to devote time for searching latest trends in technology and education.

The teachers should be interviewed by the Training Coordinator to make the final selection. **Cluster Head/Principal will be answerable if teacher is not found upto the mark during training programme** by DAVCMC or is not able to deliver result during training sessions conducted by him/her. A suggestive selection criterion for Master Trainers is-

Mandatory

- Minimum 5 years' experience of teaching these classes
- Well Informed and Updated in Subject
- **Excellent communication skills**
- Fluency in English language
- Research Oriented
- Proactive and committed to profession
- Willing to take additional work and Responsibility proactively.
- Physically fit with no serious medical history or condition.

Desirable

- Has experience of working with DAVCAE for text-book writing, paper setting etc.
- Has experience as a Teacher Trainer.

IMPORTANT

1. Kindly **DONOT nominate PRT's teaching (I to X)**for this programme. Practicing teachers of Secondary Classes should only be considered as they are fully familiar with syllabus, text-books, teaching methodology and problems of learning at this level.

2. Objectives

The 3-day Master Trainers Programme aims to create a cadre of History teachers at Secondary levels who will plan, design and conduct training programmes for their peers on a regular basis in their subject.

3. Dates & Duration

The training programme is of three day duration. The participants will report on the evening before the programme BEGINS and will be free to leave after 5.00 pm on the third (the final day) of training.

4. Participation

From every Cluster one/two/three teachers will be nominated for Secondary Programme. Where more than one teacher is required from a cluster, than under no circumstances, all teachers should be sent from the same school.

5. Workshop Requirements

The teachers will need to carry the following items for effective participation in the programme:

- **Laptop ,Text Books**

The weather conditions may be checked and all participants may be advised to carry weather appropriate clothes and footwear along with their items of personal and regular use such as medicines, toiletries etc. Please do not carry any valuables such as jewelry, expensive gadgets etc.
