

Selection Criteria for Master Trainer in Secondary Level (Classes IX-X)

Status: Only permanent TGT/PGT with Science background and in-depth understanding of curriculum.

Qualification: B.Sc or M.Sc, B.Ed

Experience:

- **Having a minimum of 3 – 5 years of teaching experience.** Can include adhoc teachers who teach efficiently.
- **Should have a training experience of conducting in-service training.**

Competencies:

- Well acquainted with curriculum and NCERT books of Secondary Level and been teaching classes IX-X.
- Familiar with problems faced by teachers and learning obstacles for learners.
- Good communication skills
- Well versed with ICT
- **Possesses leadership qualities and capable of addressing an audience.**
- **Exhibits willingness to learn new things and ready to give further training.**

Attitudes:

- The proposed MT should be keen for self growth and that of her colleagues.
- Recognizes originality and novelty in ideas and does not hesitate to put them into action
- Welcomes healthy and constructive criticism and uses it for self improvement and up-gradation.
- Sensitive to individual needs of the learners.

Communication Skills:

- Can give clear instructions to the delegates.
- All Cluster Heads are requested to send selection criterion to all schools under his /her care and ask the principals to propose the name of teacher teaching G. Science at Secondary level who can be an effective Master Trainer. Also ask the proposed master trainers to prepare four to five minutes presentation on challenges in teaching G. Science at Secondary level, form a committee to grade their presentation and do the selection accordingly.
