
Complementary or Opposite Colours


There are three basic colours, red, yellow and blue. To get the colour that is complementary to or opposite of red, simply mix the remaining two primary colours, yellow and blue. You will get the green colour. Thus, the green colour is complementary to red. Following this method, we have three pairs of complementary colours.




The opposite or complementary colour of red is green.

The opposite or complementary colour of yellow is purple.

The opposite or complementary colour of blue is orange.




